ONE DAY IN PEACE

JANUARY 1, 2000

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire is a state that sincerely embraces life, liberty and the pursuit of peace; and

WHEREAS, the pursuit of peace will lessen violence as the world unites in a common goal; and

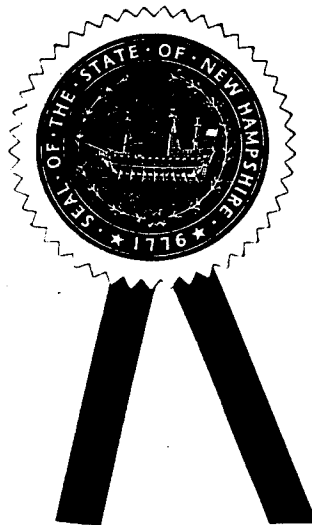
WHEREAS, numerous leaders of countries all around the world and government leaders in the United States have agreed to begin the new millennium with a worldwide day of peace to be called One Day in Peace, January 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, One Day in Peace, January 1, 2000 will serve as a symbolic beginning of cooperation between all peoples in our global, national and local communities; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire joins with all those who advocate spreading the message of hope and opportunity through peaceful pursuits;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JEANNE SHAHEEN, GOVERNOR, of the State of New Hampshire, do hereby declare **JANUARY 1, 2000** as **ONE DAY IN PEACE** in the State of New Hampshire, and urge all of its citizens to start the new millennium with a new commitment to fostering peaceful pursuits.

Given at the Executive Chamber in Concord, this first day of December, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and ninety-nine, and of the independence of the United States of America, two hundred and twenty-three.
