WHEREAS, we can help create peaceful communities by focusing on how we interact with our families, our neighbors and co-workers; and

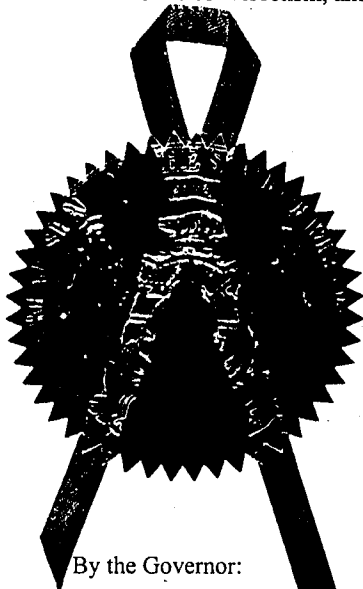
WHEREAS, we can lessen violence and separation when we pull together for a common goal; and
